Some Ideas of how to Play & Discover with Nuts & Bolts

Learning Colours

Sort the pieces by colour.

Learning to Count

Make a small pile of nuts and bolts. Help your child to count the total number of pieces, the number of each colour or the number of each shape.

Matching the Pattern

Pattern matching is used in Early Years maths teaching. Lay several different shapes in a row and ask the child to copy the sequence. Repeat this exercise using both nuts and bolts to make a more difficult pattern.

Improve Dexterity

Children need to learn to control small movements of hands and fingers. Joining the nuts and bolts is excellent practice. Ask your child to screw together some nuts and bolts.


Note:
