Some Ideas of how to Play & Discover with Play People

Learning Colours

Sort the people by colour.

Learning to Count

Make a small pile of Play People. Help your child to count the total number of pieces or the number of each colour.

Matching the Pattern

Pattern matching is used in Early Years maths teaching. Lay or join a few play people in a particular pattern of colours and ask the child to copy the sequence. Repeat this exercise using a more difficult pattern.

Improve Dexterity

Children need to learn to control small movements of hands and fingers. Joining the Play People together is excellent practice.

Play People can also be used in imaginative play and story telling.

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
