

More Ideas

Knitting Nancy Kit

Tips and Instructions

The content in this pack will make at least 4 items (hairband, butterfly, heart and wrist band).

The notes show you which wool to use if you want to make all of them.

All measurements stated are from the top of the Knitting Nancy.

Personalise the plain wooden Knitting Nancy by adding some of the stickers .


Knitting Nancy

How to use:

If you have not used a Knitting Nancy before and need to learn the basic techniques we suggest you look at: Youtube French Knitting Fiber flux, Episode 108

To thread the first length of wool through the Nancy, You may find it easier to wind the piece of wool round the end of a pipe cleaner, folding back the pipe cleaner so it does not fall off.

Then drop the pipe cleaner and wool down through the Nancy.



Dinosaur Wrist Band

How to make:

 Using the teal blue wool, make a length of 16cms

Cast off (as shown in the u-tube video quoted on the page before but DO NOT pull the last stitch tight.
This will leave a small hole.

 Cut off the end of the wool leaving approx. 19cm

 Remove your knitting carefully from the Nancy

 Thread a pipe cleaner through the eye of the sewing needle and bend it back to secure in place.

 Starting at the loose end where you cast off, pull the needle and pipe cleaner through the length of knitting

 Pull the work tight so that it completely covers the pipe cleaner

To decorate:

. Cut 3 lengths of pipe cleaner each 3cm long

Fold each pipe cleaner in half and make 3 \(\) shapes,
leaving a 0.5 cm flat length at both ends of each pipe cleaner
(these will be tucked into the knitted band)

 Place the 3 pipe cleaners evenly along the 16cm length of knitting, tucking each flat piece of pipe cleaner into it

· Stick the wiggle eyes in place

· Tie both ends of the wool together round your wrist

Heart

How to make:

- Leaving 25 cm of wool at the start of your knitting, use the Cerise wool to make a length of 15cms
- Cast off (as shown in the u-tube video) but DO NOT pull the last stitch tight. This will leave a small hole.
- Cut off the end of the wool leaving a length of approx. 10cm.
- Remove your knitting carefully from the Nancy
- Thread a pipe cleaner through the eye of the sewing needle and bend it back to secure in place
- Starting at the loose end where you cast off, pull the needle and pipe cleaner through the length of knitting
- Bend the knitting round to make a heart shape
- Tie both loose sends of wool together to complete the hea
- Thread beads onto one length of wool
- Use the second length of wool to hang up
 the heart

Hairband

How to make:

- Using the Lilac wool, make a length of 40cm to cover the hair band
- Cast off (as shown in the video) but DO NOT pull the last stitch tight. This will leave a small hole
- Cut off the end of the wool leaving a length of approx. 10cm
- Remove your knitting carefully from the Nancy
- Starting at the loose end where you cast off, thread the head band through the centre of the knitting
- Pull the work tight so that it completely covers the headband
- Sew up both ends

Flower:

- . Using the Teal blue wool make a length of 40cm
- Curl the length to make 5 petals and using the ends of the wool sew them together at the centre to make a flower shape





- . Using the Yellow wool make a length of 30cm
- Curl the length to make 4 petals and sew together (as above)
- Sew the smaller flower on top of the larger one.
- . Stick the foam shape onto the centre of the flower
- Stick the large gemstone onto the centre of the foam shape.
- Sew the flower onto the hairband

Butterfly Book Mark

How to make:

Wings:

- Using the Cerise wool, make a length of 66cm.
- Shape it into 4 wings and sew together

Body:

- Using the yellow wool, make a length of 7cm (You may not be able to measure this length easily but it will use approx. 110cm of wool)
- Cast off (as shown in the video) but DO NOT pull the last stitch tight. This will leave a small hole.
- . Remove your knitting carefully from the Nancy
- Thread the pipe cleaner throug the last stitch and bend over the top of the pipe cleaner to make Ω antennae
- · Pull the work tight.
- Sew the body on to the wings and decorate with the small demotranes
- Glue the butterfly on to the follipop
